# Design and Landmarks Committee (DLC)

- Established in 1990 as Historic Review Committee
- Has morphed over time (name, role, responsibility)
- Provides recommendations to PC
  - Downtown Design Review
  - Historic Resources
- On hiatus since August 2022 (post DDR update)



## **Proposed Action**

- Discuss retiring the DLC
  - Updated Downtown Design Review (DDR) Code
  - Historic Resource review still applies
  - Infrequent DDR and Historic Resource Review required
  - Planning Commission has capacity for review
  - Other Comprehensive Plan implementation work plan priorities
  - Maintaining a committee that is needed infrequently with no current on-going project requires significant staff resources



## Next Steps

- If DLC is retired
  - Engage community members on specific working committees for future projects related to historic resources
  - Update the code to adjust DDR & HRR review processes (without DLC role)

## History of DLC Review

#### <u>Since 2004</u>

- 60 design review applications
- 13 reviewed by the DLC
- (.68 per year)

#### <u>Since 1990</u>

- 30 historic resource applications
- Since 1998 8 reviewed by DLC (.32 per year)
