#### **TSP OVERVIEW**

- Identifies transportation goals/policies
- Inventories transportation assets/deficiencies
- Is future-oriented, i.e., what will we need in 20 years?
- Identifies and prioritizes projects

- Must be consistent with regional and state rules
- Is required for state/federal funding

#### TSP OBJECTIVES

- Identify and address the range of needs and preferences in historically underrepresented groups
- Remove barriers to equitable outcomes for all community members
- Engage with Neighborhood District Associations, community members, business owners, first responders, and other civic groups to receive input in developing the updated TSP



#### TSP OBJECTIVES

- Make transportation facilities safe for everyone with a focus on vulnerable users
- Design, implement and maintain a balanced and multimodal transportation system with an emphasis on pedestrians, cyclists, rollers, and transit use
- Reduce VMT and greenhouse gas emissions
- Respond to population growth, evolving land use patterns, revised state statues, and identified community priorities
- Identify a flexible and implementable funding strategy





- 37.8-45% Renter Occupied Households Like the state and higher than the county – about 29%
- 5.4 8.2% Living Below Poverty Level Smaller than statewide share - about 12.1%
- **\$78k** Median Household Income Less than the county median – about \$95k and lower than comparable Portland Metro Cities
- 8.3 % Single Parent Households -3/4 female-headed, like state and county share
- **11.6 15.8%** of Milwaukians live with a disability About the same as the state and county
- 2% of couple households are same-sex Greater than the county and state share - 1% and 1.3%



#### 20-Year Forecast (2023 Dollars)




