## Site Coordinators play a key role in SMART's mission!

Support children's literacy in your community and inspire a love of books and reading. You'll have the opportunity from September through May to:

- Create a welcoming, organized, and comfortable reading space.
- Work with elementary school or Head Start staff to pair and schedule students and volunteers.
- Impact your community by volunteering between 2 and 10 hours a week depending on your schedule and the school's needs.
- Provide program oversight during reading sessions.
- Participate in initial training sessions (9-12 hours total), plus attend other trainings and meetings throughout the year.
- Receive ongoing support, in group settings and one-on-one.
- Network with other community members around early childhood literacy.
- Work directly with SMART staff to ensure program outcomes, while simultaneously strengthening your skillset and knowledge base.
- Learn the ins and outs of using SMART's Google Docs database.
- Maintain a diverse, exciting SMART book inventory at the site, consisting of both classic and new fiction and non-fiction titles.
- Keep your resume up to date.
- Watch children take home books and build their own libraries!
