SE LINWOOD AVENUE PROJECT

Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) is the City of Milwaukie's program to improve safety for people walking, biking and more. SAFE calls for upgrading our network of connections such as sidewalks, ramps, and crossings to fill network gaps, replace portions that don't meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and remove barriers for people to safely get to where they need to go.

Updated project design ready for review

The City of Milwaukie has made progress on the project design for the Linwood Avenue Project, including the following:

- Constructing a separated bike and pedestrian path on both sides of Linwood Avenue
- Installing a permanent diverter and other safety measures at the intersection of Linwood Avenue and Monroe Street
- Striped crosswalks and flashing pedestrian signals north and south of Linwood Elementary School
- Landscaped planter strips with street trees
- Southbound left turn lane removal at SE Cedarcrest Drive

Timeline

The design phase will last through mid-2020, with construction anticipated to begin late summer 2020.
