LINWOOD AVENUE SAFE PROJECT

Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) is the City of Milwaukie's program to improve safety for people walking, biking and more. SAFE calls for upgrading our network of connections such as sidewalks, ramps, and crossings to fill network gaps, replace portions that don't meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and remove barriers for people to get where they need to go safely.

GETTING AROUND THE FIRST WEEKS OF SCHOOL

The Linwood Avenue SAFE project is not quite complete but we are ready to safely serve the students of Linwood Elementary/Sojourner School!

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The school driveway is open for student drop off and pick up. Please drive slowly.
- The multiuse path on the east side of the street is complete but the west side is not. Please cross at the new flashing pedestrian signals in front of the school and at Furnberg Road, and **use the east side path.**
- The temporary path behind the staging yard near the school will be open.

The entire project should be complete by the end of October. **Parts of the street are still in the active construction zone. Please stay on approved paths for your safety.**
