
Project Benefits

The following will be improved with the updates included in this plan:

- Pedestrian safety: New sidewalks will be added to the west side of SE 22nd Avenue and the east side of SE River Road. Additionally, two new pedestrian refuge islands with painted crosswalks will be added (see map for locations).
- Bicyclist safety: Clear markings will be painted in the bike lanes.

- Connectivity to other regional trails: New sidewalks will connect to nearby regional trails including the Trolley Trail and Kronberg multi-use path.
- Stormwater drainage: New landscaped planter strips will be added in some locations along SE 22nd and River Road to slow runoff and filter pollutants before they enter stormwater catch basins.
- Road Maintenance: SE 22nd Avenue and River Road will be repayed to extend road lifespan.

Timeline

Final design will consider feedback from the upcoming open house. The SAFE Program timeline has construction to be completed in 2021.
