
River Road /23rd Avenue / Lark Street Intersection Fact sheet

With the completion of the sidewalk along the east side of River Road, there have been some traffic pattern changes at the intersection of River Road / 23rd Avenue / Lark Street with the installation of the pedestrian refuge island.



Vehicular traffic travels around the island in a counter-clockwise direction.

Follow Oregon Driving Rules:

- Posted maximum speed on River Road at this intersection is 25 miles per hour (MPH)
- 23rd Avenue and Lark Street are residential districts so the maximum speed is 25 MPH*
- You must obey all official signs, signals, and markings unless you see a police officer or road worker redirecting traffic*
- There will be times when you need to yield so another vehicle can proceed. Yielding means you must slow down or stop to allow another vehicle or pedestrian to continue safely.*
- Stop before you enter or cross a road not controlled by signs or signals. Yield to approaching vehicles and pedestrians.*
