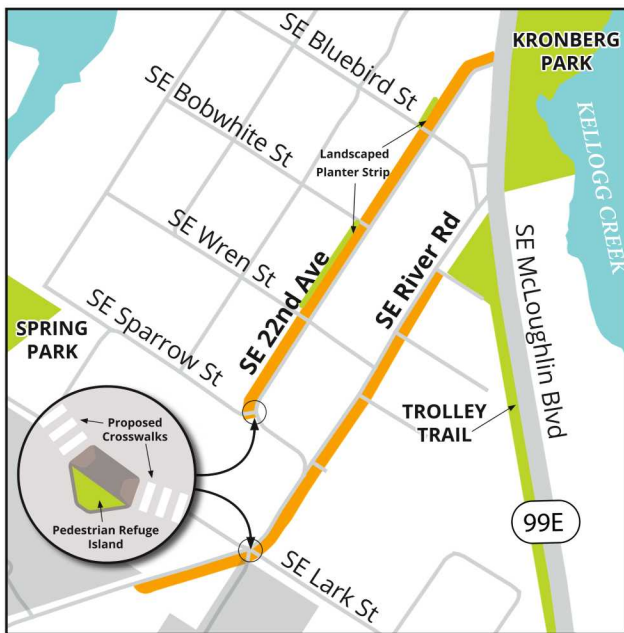




SE 22ND AVENUE AND RIVER ROAD PROJECT

Remove Items in the public right-of-way prior to construction

If you live along the project corridor, please remove any landscaping items, or other objects in the public right-of-way that you wish to keep, before construction. The crew will remove and dispose of them if they remain. Contact us if you have questions about your belongings in the right-of-way.

What You Can Expect During Construction

- Construction hours will be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday.
- Tree and shrub trimming will occur in some locations to preserve tree health, allow construction vehicle access, and as required by the Milwaukie City Code.
- Some streets will be temporarily closed to through traffic, but access will remain for local residents. Expect up to 15-minute delays during hours of construction.
- Expect on-street parking restrictions in active areas.
- Some equipment may be stored overnight within the right-of-way on neighboring streets.
- SE River Road and 22nd Avenue will be closed to all traffic during roadway paving work. Neighbors will be notified in advance.

Project Overview

As part of this program, we will be making the following updates:

- Constructing sidewalks and ADA accessible curb ramps.
- Adding new crosswalk markings and bike symbols in bike lanes.
- Repaving both streets for a smoother surface.
- Removing a water pressure control vault at SE Sparrow Street and replacing it at SE Wren Street.
