Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) is the City of Milwaukie's program to improve safety for people walking, biking and more. SAFE calls for upgrading our network of connections, such as sidewalks, ramps and crossings to fill network gaps, replace portions that don't meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and remove barriers for people to get where they need to go safely.

PROJECT UPDATE

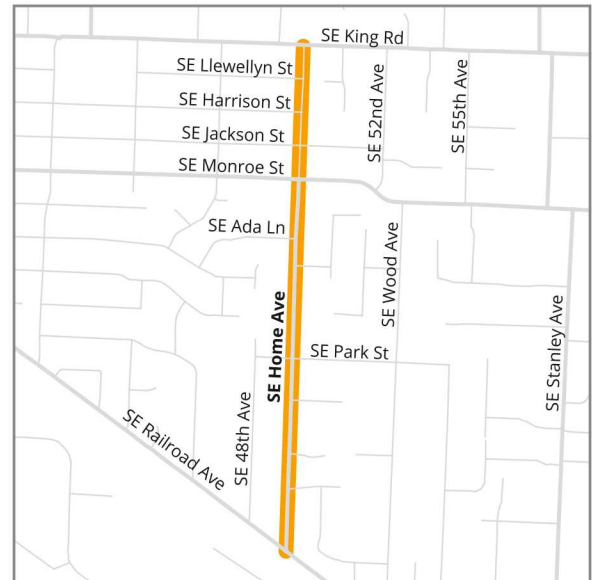
The project team is beginning to consider design options for a new sidewalk on SE Home Avenue. It's important to the City that we gather feedback on which side of the street the sidewalk should be constructed and other considerations to meet project goals.

PROJECT GOALS INCLUDE:

- Construct a continuous, 5-foot wide ADA compliant sidewalk on one side of the street.
- Preserve healthy trees as much as possible.
- Minimize impacts to existing public infrastructure and private property.
- Repave the roadway to increase the lifespan and function of the street.
- Implement needed sewer repairs on SE Harrison Street (between SE 47th and Home Avenues) and on SE Home Avenue (between SE Harrison and Monroe Streets).

UPDATED TIMELINE

Design work for the SE Home Avenue project will last through 2020, with construction anticipated to begin in summer 2021. To reduce construction costs, the City has bundled this project with the Edison Street SAFE & Street Surface Maintenance Program (SSMP) project and the Wood Avenue SSMP project for design and construction.
