



SAFE ACCESS FOR EVERYONE
IN MILWAUKIE

SE EDISON STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) is the City of Milwaukie’s program to improve safety for people walking, biking and more. SAFE calls for upgrading our network of connections such as sidewalks, ramps, and crossings to fill network gaps, replace portions that don’t meet American Disability Act (ADA) standards, and remove barriers for people safely get to where they need to go.

As part of this program, we will be making the following improvements between Highway 224 and SE 35th Avenue:

- Constructing a continuous sidewalk on the north side of Edison Street.
- Reconstructing the degraded roadway on Edison Street.

Timeline

Design of this project is just getting started. Crew members will begin surveying the area to better understand the site conditions in early October. The design phase will last through early next year, with construction anticipated to begin summer 2020.

There will be several opportunities for neighbors to learn more about the project. We will be in touch with neighbors once an initial design is ready for review.
