#### **SCHEDULE**

We'll design through January 2023. We expect construction to begin spring 2023 and last until fall 2023. Washington Street will likely have temporary road closures during construction.

We'll host a public open house later this year to share progress of the design and get to community feedback.



#### WHAT'S HAPPENING

We're designing a project to replace underground pipes, add or improve sidewalks, and repave Washington Street. We'll combine six smaller improvement projects into one large project to save money, improve efficiency and reduce the number of times we dig up the streets.

Washington Street is an important connector between downtown Milwaukie and OR 224 and many school children use it to get to school. The project is funded in part through Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE), the City's program to improve safety for walking, biking and more. The SAFE fee is part of your utility bill. ### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Replace the sanitary sewer mainline pipe on Washington Street between 34th Avenue and Sellwood Street.
- Replace the stormwater mainline pipe on Washington Street between 32nd Avenue and Oak Street.
- Construct stormwater management improvements at various locations on Madison Street and Sellwood Street.
- Replace the water mainline pipe on Washington Street between 28th Avenue and Oak Street.

- Replace a culvert (structure that channels water) for Spring Creek under Washington Street just east of 27th Avenue.
- Repave Washington Street from 23rd Avenue to 35th Avenue, Edison Street from 35th Avenue to 37th Avenue, and 27th Avenue from Washington Street to Lake Road.
- Build or replace sidewalk and curb ramps throughout the project site.
