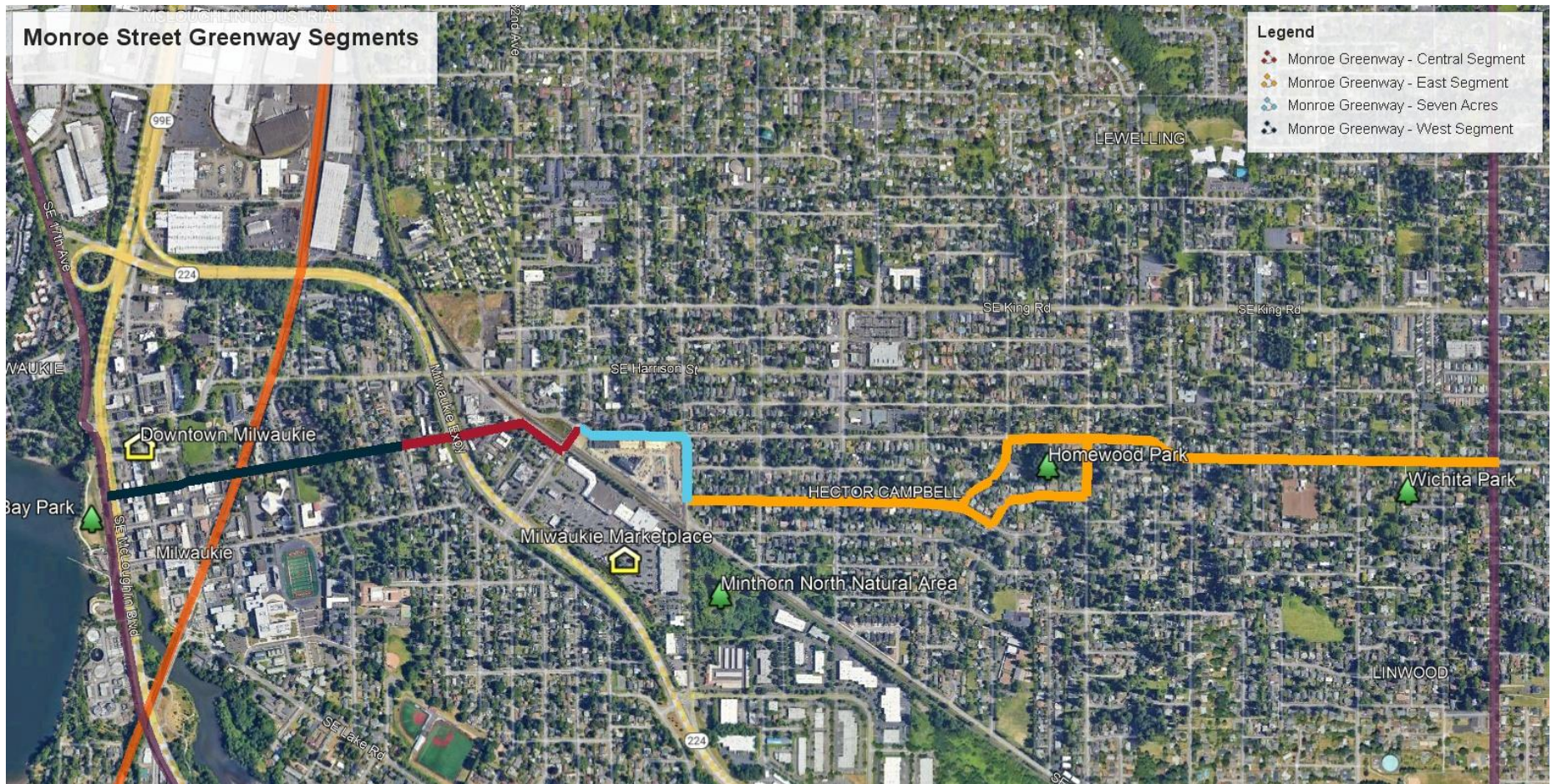

The Monroe Street Greenway will run from the Trolley Trail at Milwaukie Bay Park through downtown Milwaukie and all the way to the multi-use paths constructed along Linwood Ave. Separately, Clackamas County will extend the Linwood multi-use paths to the Springwater Corridor and is undertaking design and construction of the Monroe Street Greenway from Linwood Avenue to Fuller Road.
