



SELLWOOD STREET TO MADISON STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) is the City of Milwaukie’s program to improve safety for people walking, biking and more. SAFE calls for upgrading our network of connections such as sidewalks, ramps, and crossings to fill network gaps, replace portions that don’t meet American Disability Act (ADA) standards, and remove barriers for people to get where they need to go safely.

As part of this program, we will construct sidewalks and new ramps in the Sellwood neighborhood at the following locations:

- **SE Sellwood Street** from 30th Avenue to 35th Avenue
- **SE 30th Avenue** from Sellwood Street to Madison Street
- **SE Madison Street** from 30th Avenue to the west end

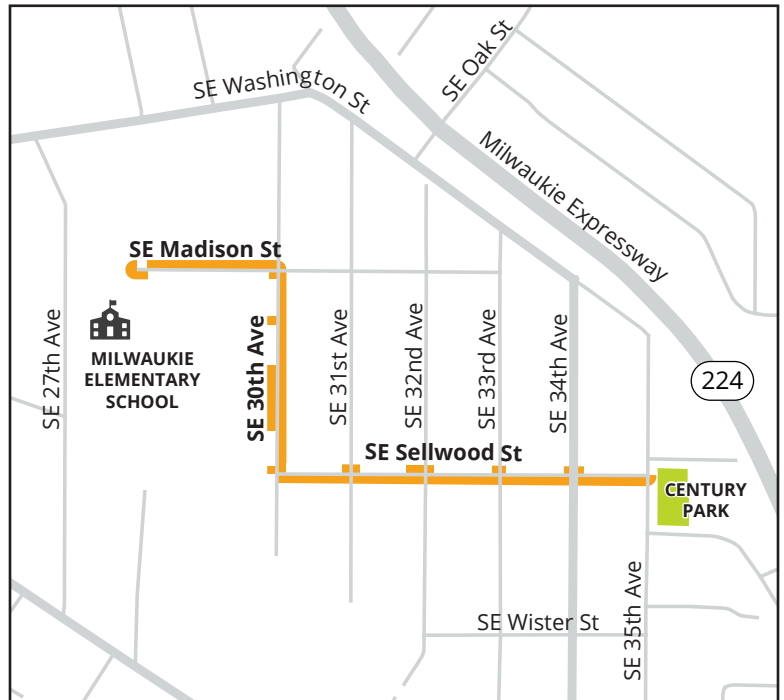
The improvements will increase safety, improve walkability of the neighborhood, and create a Safe Route to School for Milwaukie Elementary/El Puente Elementary students.

Timeline

Construction is anticipated to begin in early January 2019. In the meantime, you may see crew members in the neighborhood marking locations and getting ready for this work.
