

SAFE ACCESS FOR EVERYONE IN MILWAUKIE

ARDENWALD ELEMENTARY IMPROVEMENTS


Safe Access for Everyone (SAFE) is the City of Milwaukie's program to improve safety for people walking, biking, and more. SAFE calls for upgrading our network of connections such as sidewalks, ramps, and crossings to fill network gaps; replacing portions that don't meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards; and, removing barriers for people to get where they need to go safely.

As part of this project, the City's contractor will construct 5-foot wide sidewalks and ramps in the public right-of-way near Ardenwald Elementary School in the following locations:

- On the north side of SE Wake Street from the corner of the school property to 39th Avenue
- On the west side of **SE 39th Avenue** from Wake Street to Roswell Street

In addition, the pathway between SE Wake and Olsen Streets will be repaved with a porous asphalt to improve walkability and safety.

The city plans to plant four new street trees in the new planter strip.





Timeline

Excavation is anticipated to begin in mid-February 2019, with construction of the new sidewalks and ramps beginning in early March. In the meantime, you might see crew members in the neighborhood marking locations and preparing for this work.
