## Agenda topics

Call to order: The meeting was called to order at 6:05 pm by Katie.

**Approval of minutes:** The minutes from the August 24<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved as written.

## New Business:

Ben Patinkin explained polling and its purpose to help inform where you start and where you want to go. It will help develop the 10 word title and 20 word question for the bond language. Polling will tell us what is important and what messages to focus on. He recommends conducting the poll in January 2016 and gather from the results of the poll when to go to vote for the bond measure, May or November. Strong educational campaign will precede the polling.

Stacey Dycus explained the need for an online survey to start us off. The survey will ask people what is important to them, information to be used in the education and polling phases. The survey will be up for a month, starting as soon as possible – October 10<sup>th</sup>? The survey will help identify concerns people have, informal focus groups, potential volunteers and donors.

Mike Selvaggio spoke about the crafting of the ballot measure to tie in the business communities, NDAs, local interest groups.

Proposed timeline: 10/10-11/10 – online poll results 11/23 – report of survey results January 2016 – polling This will determine when to go to voters: May or November

Talking points will be given to task force for presentations to whoever will let us come speak. Karin asked for a list of dos and don'ts from Prospect for speaking to groups. Before our next meeting, everyone is to think of groups to contact for the chance to present. Right now, our focus will be what people want from their library.
