Library Closure Updates

In order to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus and support public health, the Ledding Library is currently closed.

These services are now available:

- The Ledding Library is offering curbside pick-up for items on the holds shelves before we closed in March. After these have all been picked up, we will be scheduling appointments for our patrons to pick up any holds on materials in our collection.
- Our phone line (503.786.7580) is open 9:00-4:00, Monday-Friday. If you would like to place a new hold or ask a reference question, please call us. New hold requests can also be made through your LINCC account at <u>www.lincc.org</u>.
- The book drop is open.
- Due dates on all checked-out materials will be extended until at least two weeks after we reopen.
- Pick up dates for holds have been extended, and will continue to be extended, until at least one week after the library is able to reopen.

The City does not have a date at this time for reopening the facility, but we will post updates on our website and Facebook account.
