The Milwaukie Municipal Court Deferred Sentencing program is offered for the purpose of educating drivers, promoting safe driving, and reducing the number of injury related traffic collisions in our community and surrounding areas.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Pay a non-refundable court fee equal to the presumptive fine amount on the issued citation no later than 30 days after you have been approved for the program.
- Complete a court assigned traffic safety course and pay the registration fee to the education provider within 60 days of the Deferred Sentencing program approval.
- Receive no violations or criminal charges during the 6 month Deferred Sentencing program period.
- Upon successful completion of the program, the citation will be dismissed.

YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE IF:

- You have any violation or traffic crime convictions within the past 5 years, **or**
- You have any pending criminal or traffic violation cases, **or**
- You are currently enrolled in or participated in a traffic safety program in the past 10 years, **or**
- You have not had a current valid driver's license for 5 years, **or**
- You have more than one violation on your citation, **or**
- You hold a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) or permit (CLP), **or**
- There is any objection by the citing Officer, **or**
- Your citation involved an accident, occurred in a school or work zone, or is for one of the following charges:
 - Class A Traffic Violation that has a presumptive fine equal to \$440
 - Driving a Motor Vehicle While Using a Mobile Electronic Device
 - Careless Driving
 - Failure To Yield to An Emergency Vehicle

FURTHER INFORMATION

By entering the Deferred Sentencing program, you are:

1. Pleading no contest to the charge.
2. Agreeing to strictly comply with the conditions of the program. Failure to comply will result in a conviction of the charge.
3. Swearing under penalty of perjury that you meet the qualifications of the Deferred Sentencing program.
