




Plan Overview




Proposed Land Use & Urban Design Implementation

- General Mixed Use Zone
- Neighborhood Mixed Use Zone or Overlay
- Flex Space/Light Industrial Overlay
- Increase open space
- Use Edge Treatments to Create Transition Zones Between New Development and Existing Residential

- Targeted Street Upgrades




Guiding Principles

- Guiding Principles are high-level statements about Central Milwaukie's future.
- They are intended to capture citizen's values and priorities.
- They are the parameters with in which the concepts must be consistent.
- Guiding Principles also help ensure the planning process for Central Milwaukie moves forward in a predictable manner
 - Consistent with the community's shared vision for how the area can evolve to enhance the City as a whole.










Fundamental Concepts


- Fundamental Concepts are a step between Guiding Principles and Implementation Strategies.




Promote high-quality, human-scale urban design that is complementary to the surrounding area.






