- May 18th by 5pm Due date for all <u>new</u> written evidence, arguments or testimony submitted by the public and/or the applicant
- May 25th by 5pm Due date for written rebuttal by the public and/or the applicant to the new written evidence, arguments or testimony submitted by May 18th
 - What this means: Anything submitted after May 18th should be <u>in response to</u> the comments submitted between now and May 18th.

- May 25th Planning Commission hearing. At the hearing and if necessary, the PC can open the record for the limited purpose of asking clarifying questions of staff and the applicant, and will then proceed to deliberations. No public testimony will be taken at the May 25 hearing.
