

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Amendments to Milwaukie Municipal Code

The **Milwaukie Planning Commission** will hold a public hearing **at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 27, 2021** to consider a recommendation for proposed Municipal code text Amendments (File #ZA-2021-003).

## **Summary of Proposed Changes**

- Municipal Code
  - o MMC 14.018.090 Conditional and Community Service Use Signs
    - This application is for proposed amendments related to electronic display signs for Community Service Uses that are considered public high schools. Staff proposes to add language that clearly states the standards for electronic display signs for Community Service Uses. These changes provide needed clarification and will increase certainty and understanding of the process to apply for an electronic display sign.
