## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Amendments to Milwaukie Zoning Ordinance and Municipal Code

The **Milwaukie City Council** will hold a public hearing at 6:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, November 15, 2022**, at Milwaukie City Hall, 10722 SE Main Street, to consider a recommendation for proposed Municipal code text and map amendments related to middle housing land divisions (Land Use File #ZA-2022-002): <https://www.milwaukieoregon.gov/citycouncil/city-council-regular-session-336>.

This matter was previously heard by the Planning Commission at a hearing on September 17, 2022, where the Commission unanimously recommended approval of the proposed amendments. The video of that meeting can be accessed here: <https://www.milwaukieoregon.gov/bc-pc/planning-commission-104>.

### Summary of Proposed Changes

- Municipal Code – multiple sections
  - The proposed code amendments relate to:
    - consolidation of the city’s high density residential zones (R-3, R-2.5, R-2, R-1, and R-1-B) into three (3) zones
    - amendments to definitions of types of residential care facilities
    - amendments to terminology and definitions of boarding houses
    - streamlining of land use review processes for some uses in the high density zones
    - associated amendments in other code sections to ensure consistency across the code.

**To comment on a proposal:** You are invited to attend this hearing or submit comments in writing before the meeting time. You may send written comments in advance to the staff contact listed below, or you may submit your comments in person at the hearing. If you want to present verbal testimony, either pro, con, or to raise questions, you will be invited to speak following the applicant’s testimony. Testimony and comments at this hearing must be directed towards the criteria identified. If you submit a written comment or comment in person at the hearing, you will be sent a copy of the decision or recommendation. All written and verbal comments become part of the permanent record.

**Failure to raise an issue with sufficient specificity, and accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the responsible parties an opportunity to respond to the issue, will preclude any appeal on that issue to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).**
