PROPOSAL: ZONE: DMU

Proposal is part of the adaptive re-use of historic City Hall. The proposal is for an exterior alteration to the building located at 10722 SE Main St. also known in the Milwaukie Historic Resources Property List as "Milwaukie City Hall" (MCH). The proposed improvement to the structure includes modifying an existing window opening on the North façade of the building to accommodate a pair of full-lite, wood storefront doors. Also proposed is a new concrete staircase and ramp to access the new storefront, as well as new hardscaped plaza spaces in the existing landscaped areas along the East side of the building.

City Hall is listed as a Significant historic resource and the alteration (adding the door) requires historic resource review. The alteration also requires Type I Downtown Design Review.
