### **APPEAL HEARINGS**

### Appeals of MHLD:

Per ORS 197.375, the Planning Manager's decision may be appealed by the applicant or any person or organization who files written comment that identifies the issues that may provide the basis of appeal as set forth in ORS 197.375(1)(c) by the deadline for comments. An appeal must be based solely on the allegations identified in ORS 197.375(1)(c). Appeals are heard by an appointed referee or designated hearings officer as stated in ORS 197.375(2) and follow the process identified in ORS 197.375(3)–(8).

The Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) does not have jurisdiction to consider any decision, aspects of decision, or actions made under ORS 92.031 or ORS 197.360 to 197.380. Pursuant to ORS 197.375(8), any party to a proceeding before a referee may seek judicial review of the referee's decision in the manner provided for review of final orders of LUBA under ORS 197.850 and 197.855.
