The amendments were adopted by Milwaukie City Council as Ordinance #2071 on **July 2**, **2013**. The ordinance adopts the Tacoma Station Area Plan as an ancillary document to the Milwaukie Comprehensive Plan, amends the text of the Comprehensive Plan; amends Comprehensive Plan Map 7 – Land Use to depict the Tacoma Station Area; creates a new base zone for the Tacoma Station Area (Tacoma Station Area Manufacturing Zone, Section 19.312); creates a new overlay zone for the Tacoma Station Area (Tacoma Station Area Overlay Zone, Section 19.406); amends portions of the Manufacturing zone (Section 19.309), amends the Zoning Map to depict the Tacoma Station Area Manufacturing Zone an Tacoma Station Area Overlay Zone; and identifies the Tacoma Station Area as a Station Community pursuant to Title 6 of Metro's Urban Growth Management Functional Plan.
