This notice is issued in accordance with Milwaukie Municipal Code (MMC) Section 19.1008 Type V Review. The amendments were adopted by Milwaukie City Council as Ordinance #2073 on **November 19, 2013**. The ordinance amends the City's Transportation System Plan (TSP), which is an ancillary document to the Comprehensive Plan. The amendments include an adjustment of the TSP's planning horizon date from 2030 to 2035; updates to existing maps, tables, and text to reflect current conditions; a refresh of project lists to remove completed projects and add new projects; reassessment of project priorities; and an update of the funding forecast for project implementation. The amendments also confirm that the master plans for the various travel modes (e.g., pedestrian, bicycle, public transit, automobile, freight) will help the region move toward meeting its performance targets for 2035, including reductions in congestion, percentage of single-occupancy vehicle trips, and vehicle-miles traveled per capita.
