The amendments were adopted by Milwaukie City Council as Ordinance #2107 on October 20, 2015. The amendments to the Milwaukie Comprehensive Plan changed the designation of two park sites (Balfour and Bowman-Brae Parks) on the Land Use Map and adding as ancillary documents the new master plans for three park sites (Balfour, Bowman-Brae, and Kronberg Parks).
