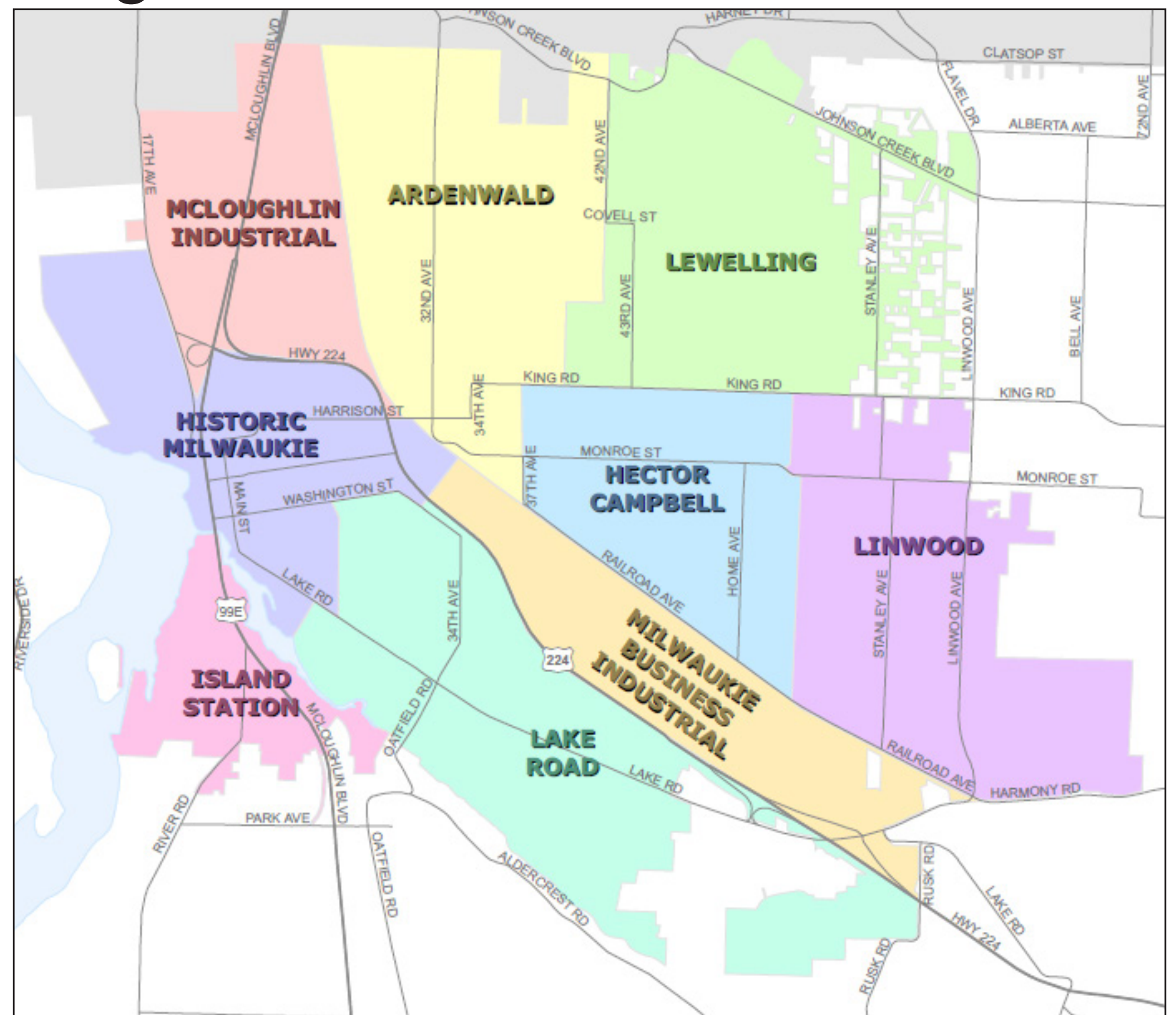

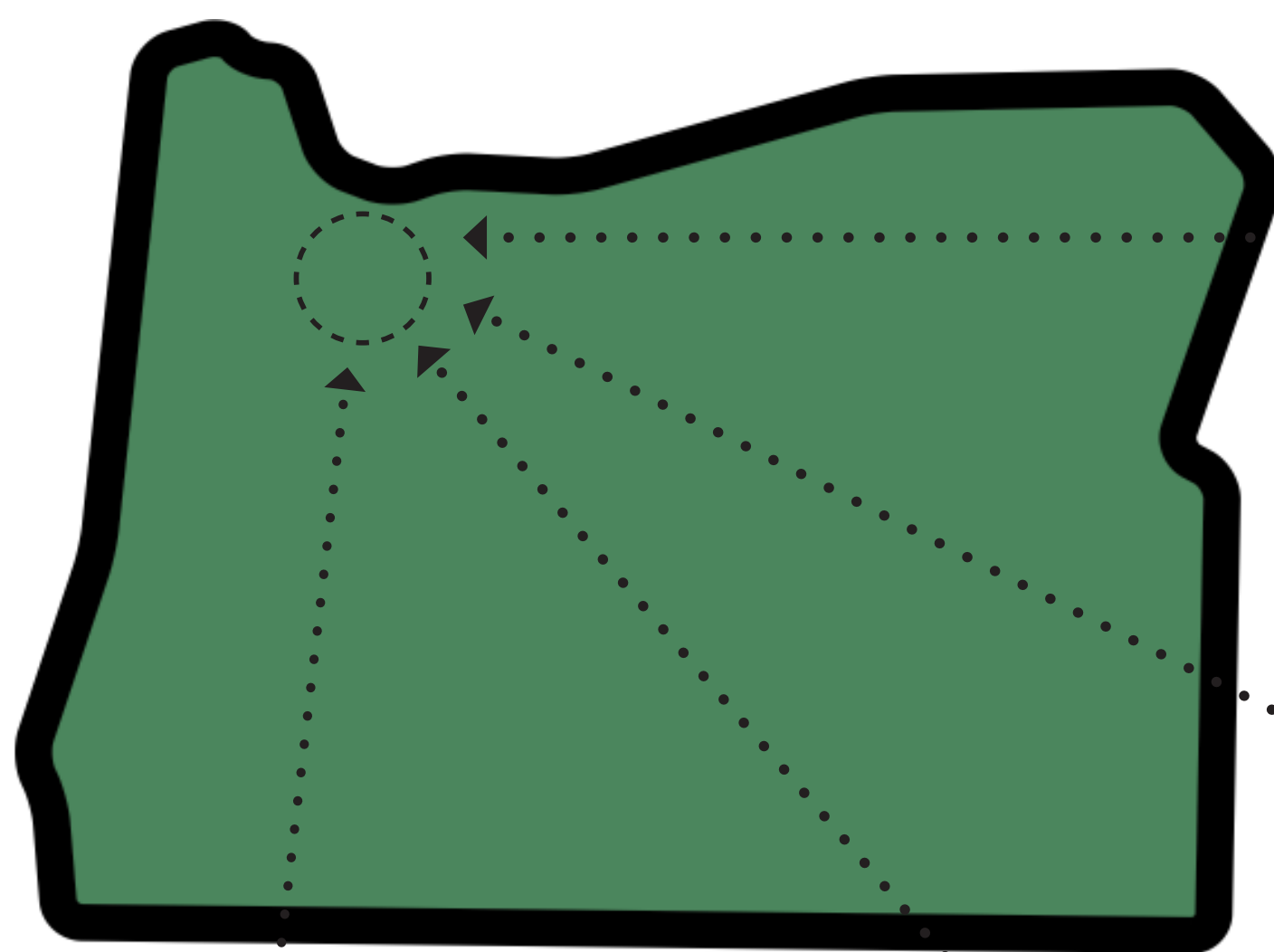

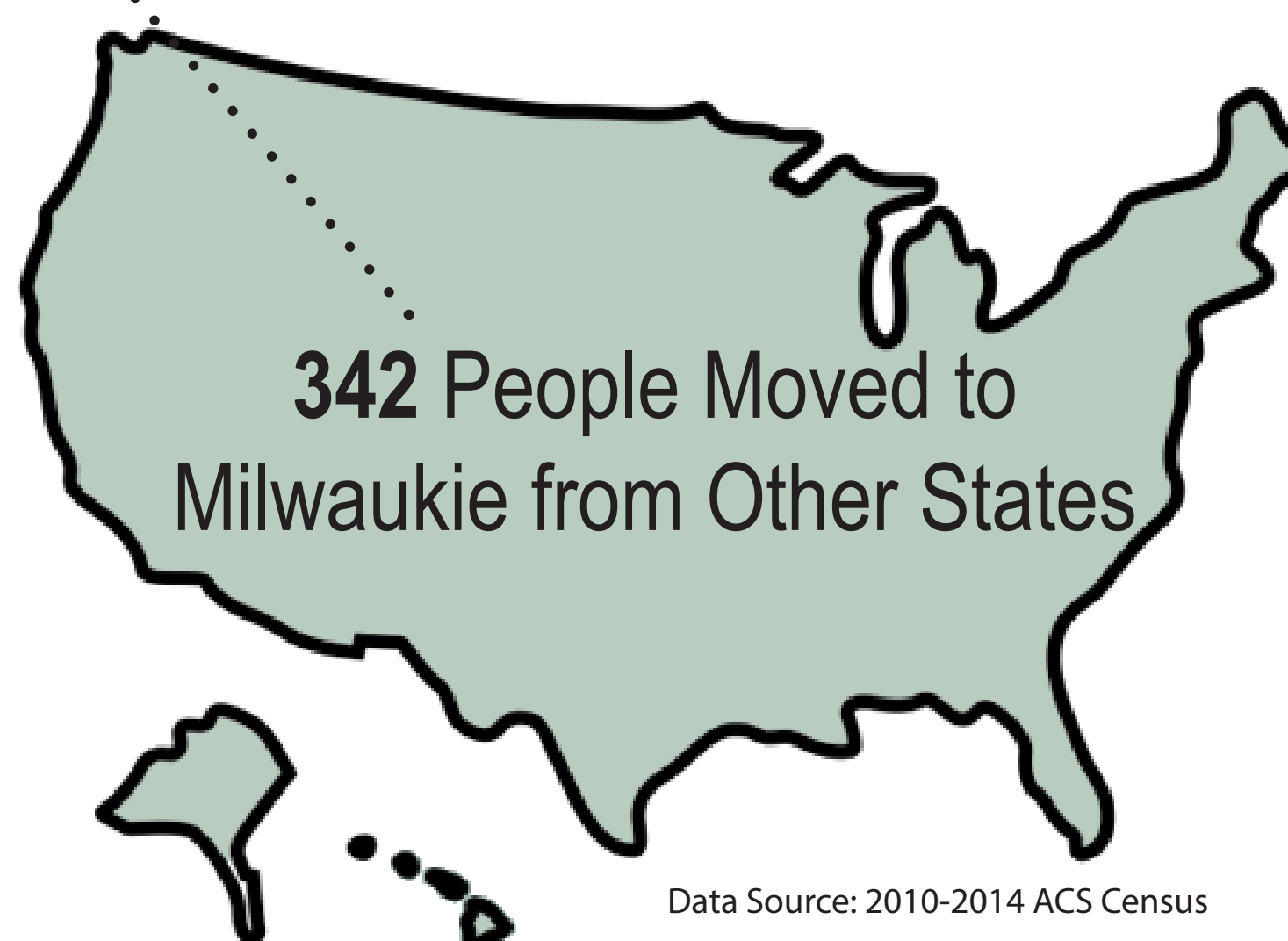
MIGRATION to Milwaukie Area

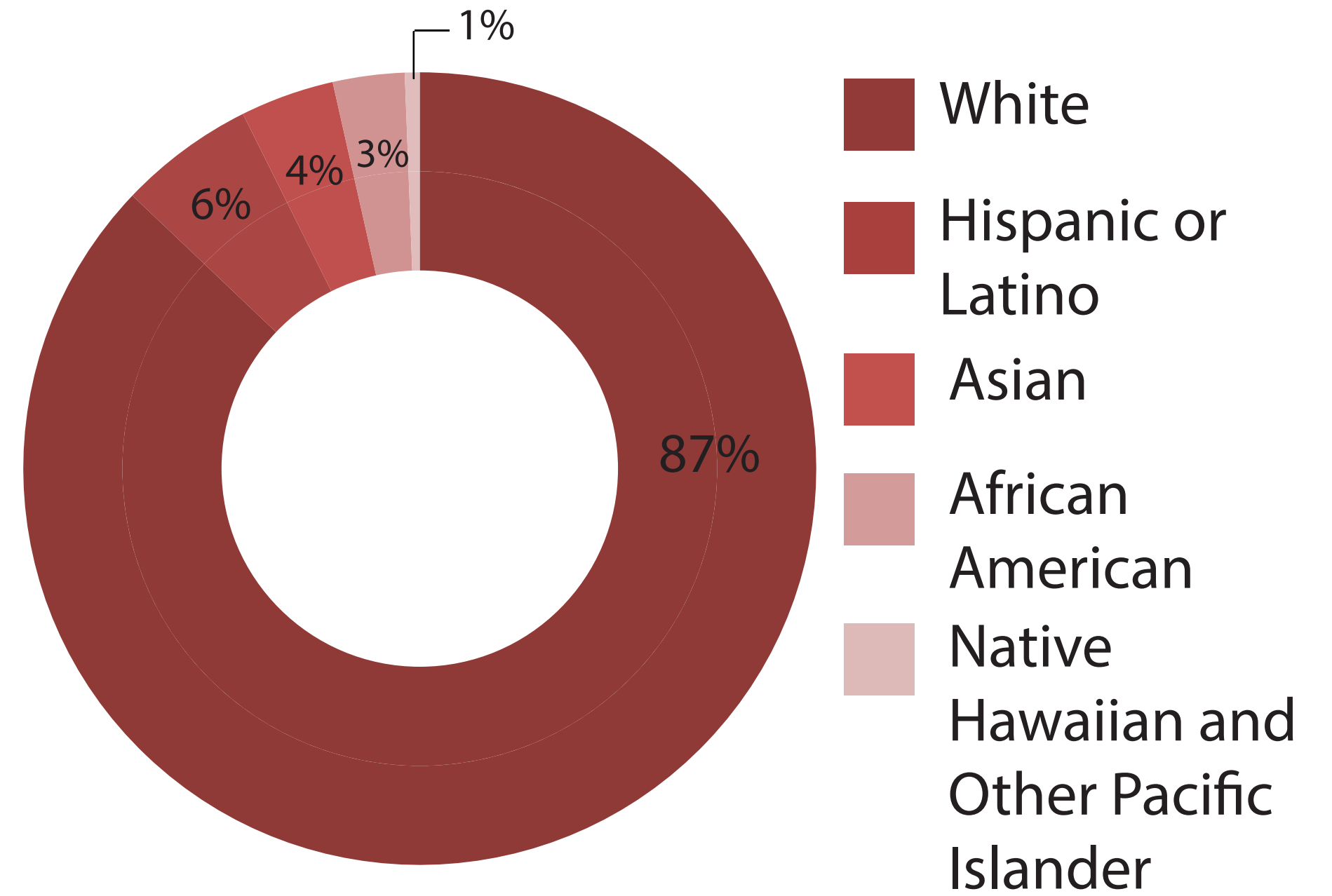
POVERTY

2,196 People were homeless in Clackamas County during 2015.

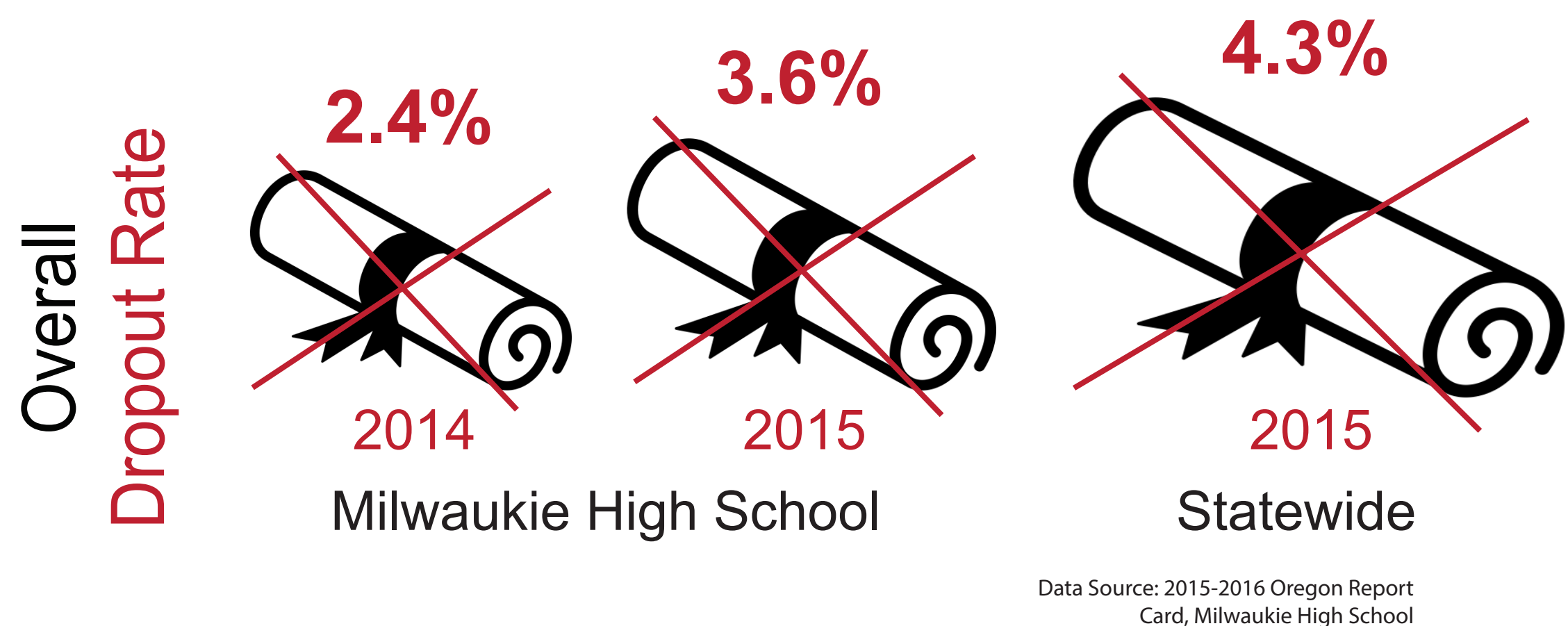
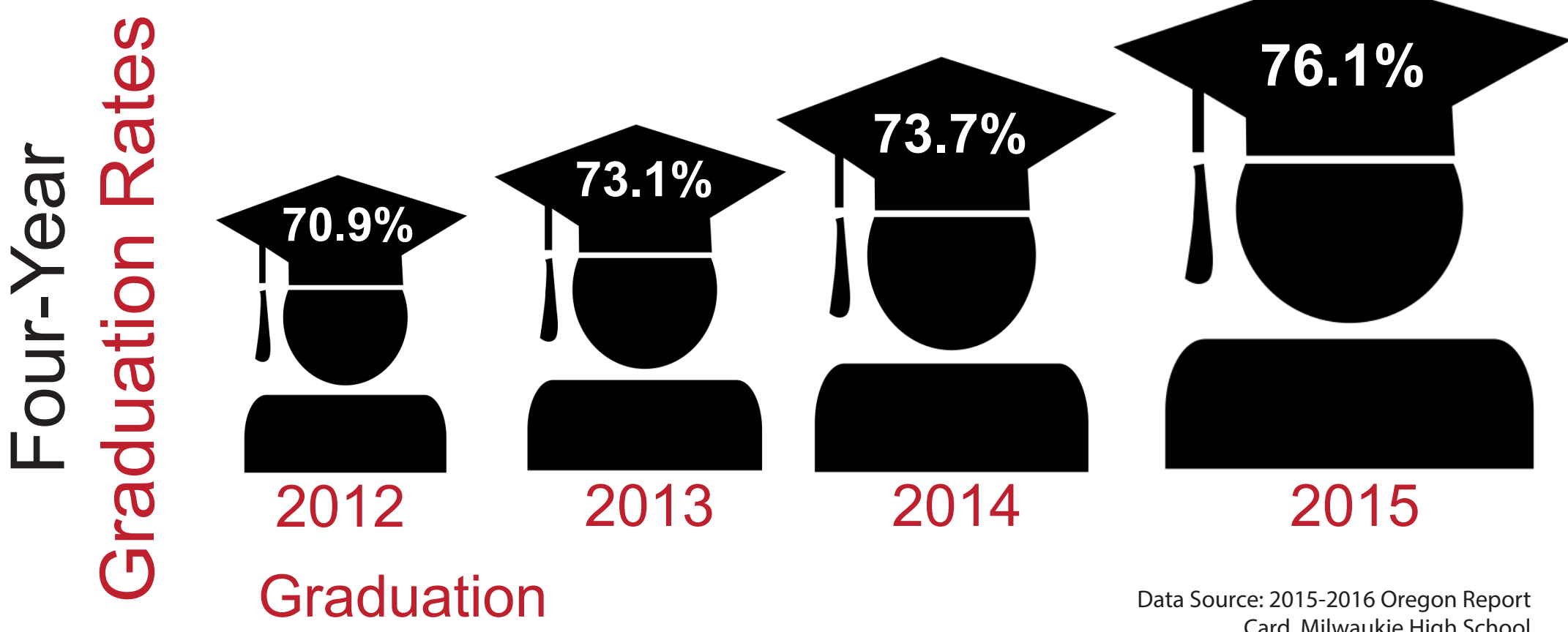

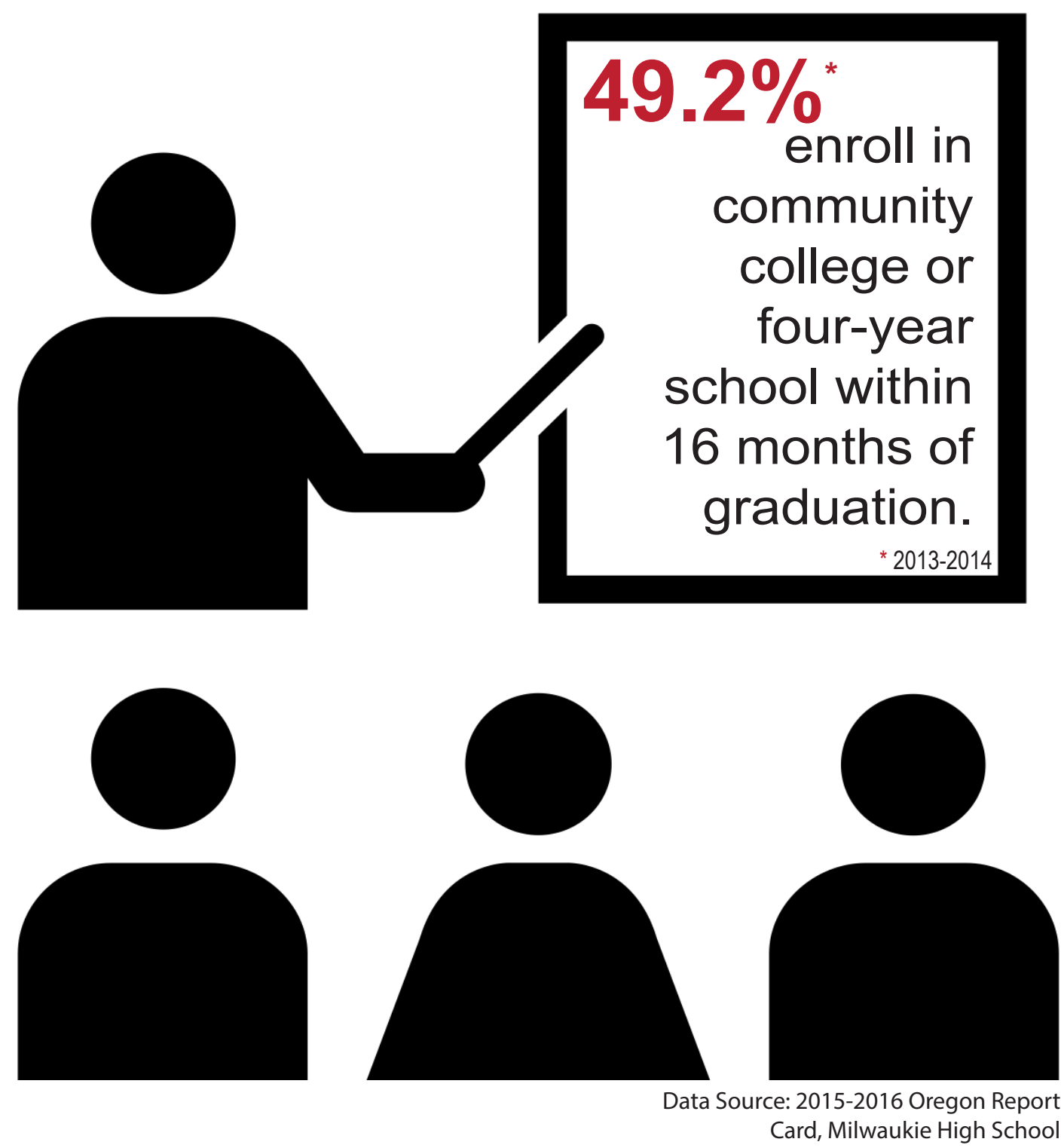
