The current council chambers in Milwaukie City Hall are proposed to be moved into the existing garage bay in the same building. The space will be updated to accommodate the necessary functional requirements of a civic space, including upgrades to meet current energy code and acoustical and security needs.

The scope of work includes replacing the existing wood windows in the garage bay with new energy efficient wood windows, replacing the existing garage doors with new energy efficient garage doors, replacing the existing swing door on the south façade with a new door, creating a new second accessible exit from the garage bay, and providing new exterior lighting above both swing doors.
