Minutes for meeting 4/8/10

7PM, Linwood Elementary School Library

Officer Scott Huteson and Jag were on hand for much of the meeting. Officer Huteson passed out the Offense Report for March and a few items were discussed, such as concerns at the intersection of Harmony/Linwood/Railroad Ave's. Also, the group was advised of the upcoming Police Open House for Cadets (youngsters of high school age who would like to volunteer to help out the Milwaukie Police Department in various roles) which will be held May 6th, 6:00PM at the Public Safety Building. All folks with interested students are encouraged to attend.

The proposed changes to requirements for parking for new residential construction was discussed. The group felt that the current requirements were better than the proposed changes and the ordinance should remain as is.

Regarding the grant request for Milwaukie Museum, the group voted to hold off on grant funding until there was more information available. Apparently the step repairs/replacement has been completed and paid for and the group felt that, while the Museum is a worthy cause, there are likely future needs that may be addressed as they come to light.

The grant request for the Sellwood Boys and Girls Club in Sellwood was voted to be \$200.00 and will be requested from the City as soon as possible.

The amount of the grant to be requested for Linwood's Movies Under the Stars was left at \$1200.00, the same as last year. The dates were set for June 25th and August 13th, at dusk and will be held at the Milwaukie Covenant Church playing field between the church and Linwood Elementary School on Linwood Ave.

The proposed "Rooster Ordinance" was distributed and discussed in brief, however, no vote was taken to recommend one way or the other as to code changes. This will likely be on the agenda for next month.
