The meeting was called to order at 6:22 p.m.

Dave asked if everyone had reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Mary made a motion to approve the minutes. Ray seconded the motion. Agreed unanimously.

Dave said the letter supporting the bicycle boulevard project grant was sent to Alex and then approved by Council.

Chief – discussed the Johnson Creek facility for the criminally insane – there are eight residents living there from the State Hospital. It is run by Columbia Care – a private company. On June 29<sup>th</sup> one of the residents tried to escape. They did not notify the P.D. in a timely manner, as is required by the good neighbor agreement. The Chief had a meeting with all the key people involved and this should not be an issue in the future. The resident was taken back to the State Hospital.

Chief – we still do not have a union contract. He's still not sure what our personnel expenditures will be. He's not going to fill the current opening for police officer until the collective bargaining agreement is in place – it is going to arbitration. He explained the hiring process for City Manager. There will be citizen panels and encouraged PSAC members to be involved.

Chief – photo radar – he heard a rumor that we were going to end the programs. It's not true. Joanne asked if they could use the radar trailer/sign on River Road. Brad will check on that.

Elections of officers – Dave asked for nominations. Dave was reelected as Chair, Ray as Vice Chair and Chief volunteered to be Secretary/Treasurer.

Brad – went over the school zone signage study. There was a discussion regarding rumble strips and painted lines. The walk safely program was passed by the Council. It will be discussed at the next meeting.

Ray – gave a light rail update. Chief said there is a new Tri-Met Police Commander. There was a discussion regarding stats/crime rates.

Susanna – gave a K-9 Walk update. We have some volunteers to help out. Water will be provided, along with coffee and pastries.

Mary said there's a new Sellwood Bridge survey available online.
