Public Comments: no comments

Capital Improvement Projects

- Meek St Project currently on pause- the railroad coordination is slowing the process down. Construction will probably be about July or August
- Hillside- Phase I- Clackamas Housing Authority – near Providence- demo happening soon and will be going through the summer. It's a county construction project. Concerns around the residents relocation was addressed by saying there will be link sent out with more details
- Ardenwald North- currently in design. Contractor will be chosen this fall and start in summer 2025
- Harvey- Presentation at Ardenwald NDA meeting
- Logus 42nd- design next year
- Monroe Greenway- 30% design – East portion- Linwood to 37th
- Washington St- active construction zone
- Kellog Creek Restoration- sediment testing this summer- will be noisy
- Waverly Heights- sewer reconfiguration- 60% design
- Waverly South- project in design: road repaving, utility improvements- summer 2025
- 2024 grind and pave project- Mid June start. Map on project website. Mailers will be going out in a few days. Door hangers will be given a few days in advance for affected residents
- Slurry seal- Begin late June and July
- Storm and sidewalk improvements- mainly on Main St & Jefferson

NDA Concerns

Linwood:

- Stanley South- which runs from King to Railroad. Question regarding the designation of a greenway no extra signage or traffic calming measures. Why?
- Engineering response: Greenways in the 2016 TSP- designated to help guide us over a number of years. It is a planning document. It doesn't necessarily mean that every street that is a greenway is required to have certain features
- It would be helpful to have a consistent definition and presentation of Greenways.
- NDA item: Campbell School now will be June 11th Planning Commission.
- General NDA- CERT is working with Dan Harris with a 2 weeks ready program. CERT is planning to come to NDA meetings in the month of September to present the new program.

Lewelling:

- Pot hole concerns 1. Hill St, east of Stanley 2. 4641 White Lake Rd.
- Vision clearance- Ivy. Need to contact code compliance
- Bike Lane maintenance: on King Rd
- Road maintenance: Johnson Creek Rd.
- Bump outs need reflectors- some do and some don't

Hector Campbell:

- Safety concern for Harrison & Hwy 224- cars may have limited visibility of anyone using the crosswalk. The intersection is under ODOT jurisdiction. Reach out to ASK ODOT- <https://highway.odot.state.or.us/cf/comments/comments.cfm>

Discussion of PSAC resource document

- Who is the audience for this?
- Use 15 min every meeting and continue to add to the document
- Shimron is going to send what he has to Ben and will add
- Safety resource pages- like *Street Roots*- resources to give to people
- PSAC History- group started in 2018- Looks at projects in the planning horizon and look at the safety of took a lot of public engagement.
- There was a lot of discussion early on. In the last few years there has been some stagnation. Current function can be described as a pathway of housekeeping for the city.
- PSAC role: identify potential problems and keeping the lines of communication open, reduce anxiety within the community

SPOT Program within SAFE- small improvements that can be done in a specific location. Ex: a speed study on a specific corridor or a bump out on one intersection. 350K non-renewable funding. The intention would be equally distributing throughout the city.

SAFE funds are collected with our utility bills

Fire Report

- Fire district newsletter on the fire district home webpage <https://clackamasfire.com/>
- Backyard burning is closed til Fall
- Fireworks prohibited in Portland and Milwaukie
- Use life jackets in water
- Keep grills and bbq clean and never unattended; make defensible space around house, grasses and brush cut low, and roof and gutters clean from combustibles.

Police Report

- Fireworks- if we do get calls, code enforcement will drive by and give warnings, may get a citation with continued complaint. 503-786-7500 is the non-emergency number to call

- Speeders- an issue which is an increasing public concern. Dept. will be purchasing 2 solar powered speed signs- intended to be educational- to encourage people to slow down- hopefully will track data. Please bring areas of concern to our awareness via NDA or PSAC.
- Detective Kathryn Meyer and canine, Flora, were in training all of last week. They finished a certification course for under water. Flora was the only dog that found every device! Dog and trainer are doing very well. Hoping to get Flora and officer to be at community events. Det. Meyer has TFO- Task Force Officer status, which gives her the ability to bring cases to the federal level.
- Stabbing occurred btw 2 people that were known to each other. Police dept. is working with the Axletree apartments to investigate the incident
- Milwaukie does not have any photo radar enforcement

Capital Improvement Projects

- Meek St- storm pipe project- we have installed pipeline along the hillside development. The next section has been delayed by railroad but we anticipate getting finished in Aug or September
- Hillside Development (across Providence Hospital) demolition starting soon
- Ardenwald North- project to improve utilities as well roadways, construction will begin next summer
- Harvey St- still in design, begin next summer
- East Monroe Greenway- bike and pedestrian facilities along Monroe- 30% design
- King Rd- 60% design- next summer construction
- Washington St- continue through the summer through to next summer
- Kellogg Creek- restoration of pond and dam removal- sediment testing with some noise
- Waverly Heights- sewer rehab – construction next summer
- Waverly South- utility upgrades- design is on hold til next fall
- 2024 grind and pave- in process now but will wrap up in July
- 2024 slurry seal project- in process now and will wrap up at the beginning of July
- Ardenwald North- in final phase of design, will begin construction 2025 spring/summer

Comments for CIP

- Stripping for bike lane on Harrison from Waldorf school to 99
- Funding comes from state gas tax and paving from transportation budget

NDA Concerns

Linwood-

- House in neighborhood- reports of drug trafficking and domestic violence.
Police comment on how neighbors can work with law enforcement if this activity is occurring:

- 1) Any vehicle that is considered abandoned (not moved within 24hrs) can be reported. Report it to the non-emergency number and they will put a sticker on the car. Another 24hrs and officer will come back and mark the tire. Next check on the vehicle and it will be impounded
- 2) Pole cameras- police dept. is in the process of purchasing 1-2. Will be putting them up for specific surveillance where needed.
- 3) Document any suspicious activity at the property; like when visitors go in and how long until they leave. An officer will write up a report on the data. Neighbors can accumulate enough circumstantial evidence to create a weighted picture that could lead to a search. Use the non-emergency number for these types of reports: 503-786-7500
- 4) In addition, Clackamas County has a mediation program

Ardenwald: no concerns

Lewelling:

- Pothole hotline- is Hill St. east of Stanley a city street? This pothole has not been fixed despite frequent complaints and nearby potholes fixed promptly.

Island Station:

- Police car requested near Spring Park. Neighbors feel this is a helpful deterrent.

Hector Campbell

- Scheduled a speed study for before Cascade Heights opens in fall and afterward as well. Speed studies are usually done for a week. Could provide numbers with interested persons.

Linwood:

- Serious accident on June 14th- Linwood /Fernberg

Lake Road:

- Striping on Lake Rd 34th Ave going east
- Neighbor asked how to get a painted crosswalk on SE Freeman on Lake Rd

Safe Routes to School

Members of the Lewelling neighborhood are in contention for a state grant for Logus and Stanley with the SRTS program, improving the safety of families walking to Lewelling Elementary. Unfortunately, they divided the grant application process into 2 parts. To bring their ranking in the process higher this citizen group has asked for letters from Lewelling NDA, the principal, senators, and now PSAC to boost chances of being awarded the grant. There was an approved motion to authorize the Chair to sign the letter.

Info on new EV charging station in Ardenwald (Filbert St., Olsen St)

- PGE managed- need the app to lower the mechanism
- Milwaukie is a test city for these new types of charging stations

TSP Advisory Committee

- 4 pillars to create standards for TSP 1) Access to transit 2) Level of traffic stress- bike and pedestrian safety
- August meeting will have time for individual concerns and fine tuning

SPOT Program

- About \$300K for safety projects within the city. It is SAFE funds set aside that the public can propose be used for small projects. The hope is the funds can be equally distributed around the city. The NDA would sponsor the request. More details to come on the application process.
- Considerations for the program: cost, schedule, private property, right-of-away, traffic regulations
- 2nd application would be in collaboration btw the NDA and the proposer
- More discussion at the next meeting in July
